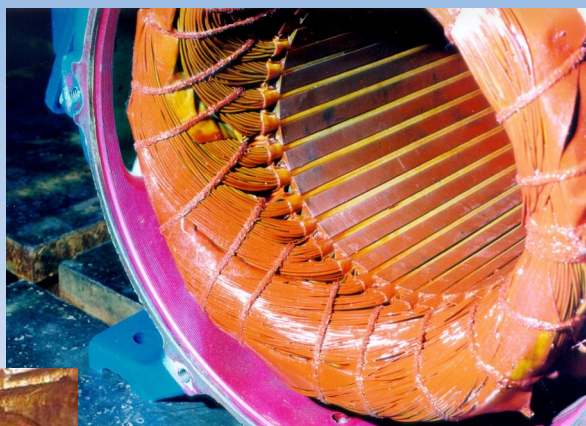

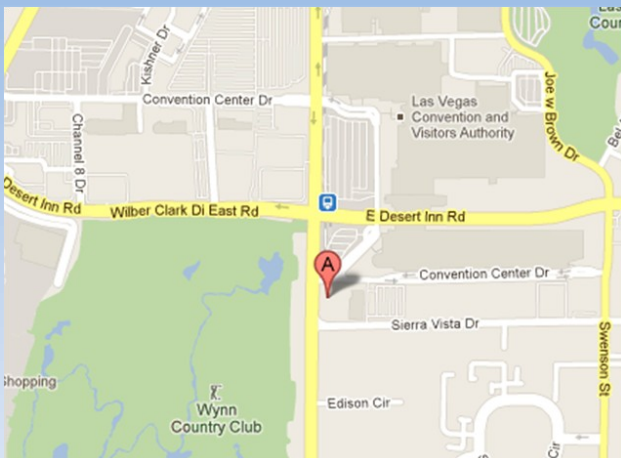

Directions to Renaissance Las Vegas

- From McCarran International Airport: Exit airport onto Swenson Avenue, merge left to take ramp to Swenson Street / Tropicana Avenue / Departing Flights. Once on Swenson Avenue, travel 1.8 miles and turn left onto Harmon Avenue. Proceed west .01 miles to Paradise Road and turn right. Continue north 1.5 miles to Renaissance Las Vegas Hotel, located on your right at Sierra Vista Drive.
- From McCarran Rental Car Facility: Head north on Gilespie Street toward East Arby Avenue. Turn right at George Crockett Road and merge left to take ramp to Swenson Street / Tropicana Avenue / Departing Flights. Once on Swenson Avenue, travel 1.8 miles and turn left onto Harmon Avenue. Proceed west .01 miles to Paradise Road and turn right. Continue north 1.5 miles to Renaissance Las Vegas Hotel, located on your right at Sierra Vista Drive.

Transportation Options

- If you choose not to rent a car, there are a variety of shuttle and limousine services available on the west side of baggage claim (outside door exits 8 – 13) at McCarran Airport.
